

PRESIDENT'S DUTIES

1. Public Relations.
2. Make decisions in all legal matters and act accordingly.
3. Help establish insurance for the Association.
4. To help establish scholarship funds for the association.
5. Know and to oversee all officials duties.
6. Secure major sponsorships for the Association,
7. Be prepared to take on any officials position if need be and to find replacements.
8. To know all rules and regulations faithfully.
9. Attend all national meetings.
10. To assist in operations of any national championship when held in Texas.
11. Call Board meetings.
12. To be the Chief Executive of the Association and to preside at all meetings of the Board.
13. Formulate the Association master plan for each year after consulting with the Vice-President and the other Board members, and present the plan at the first regular Board meeting for modification and Board approval.
14. Maintain direct contact with each Board member to advise and assist the execution of Association policy, programs and competitions.
15. Create committees to assist the Association in carrying out it's policies.
16. Coordinate an annual competition schedule for the upcoming season.
17. To make each officer and director aware of their specific duties as written in the TGSA Constitution and By-Laws.
18. The President's main duty is to coordinate the central body and it's personnel. To be aware and knowledgeable of all activities to be carried on outside the organization with other organizations. The President shall also make spot decisions that cannot wait for full Board action.
